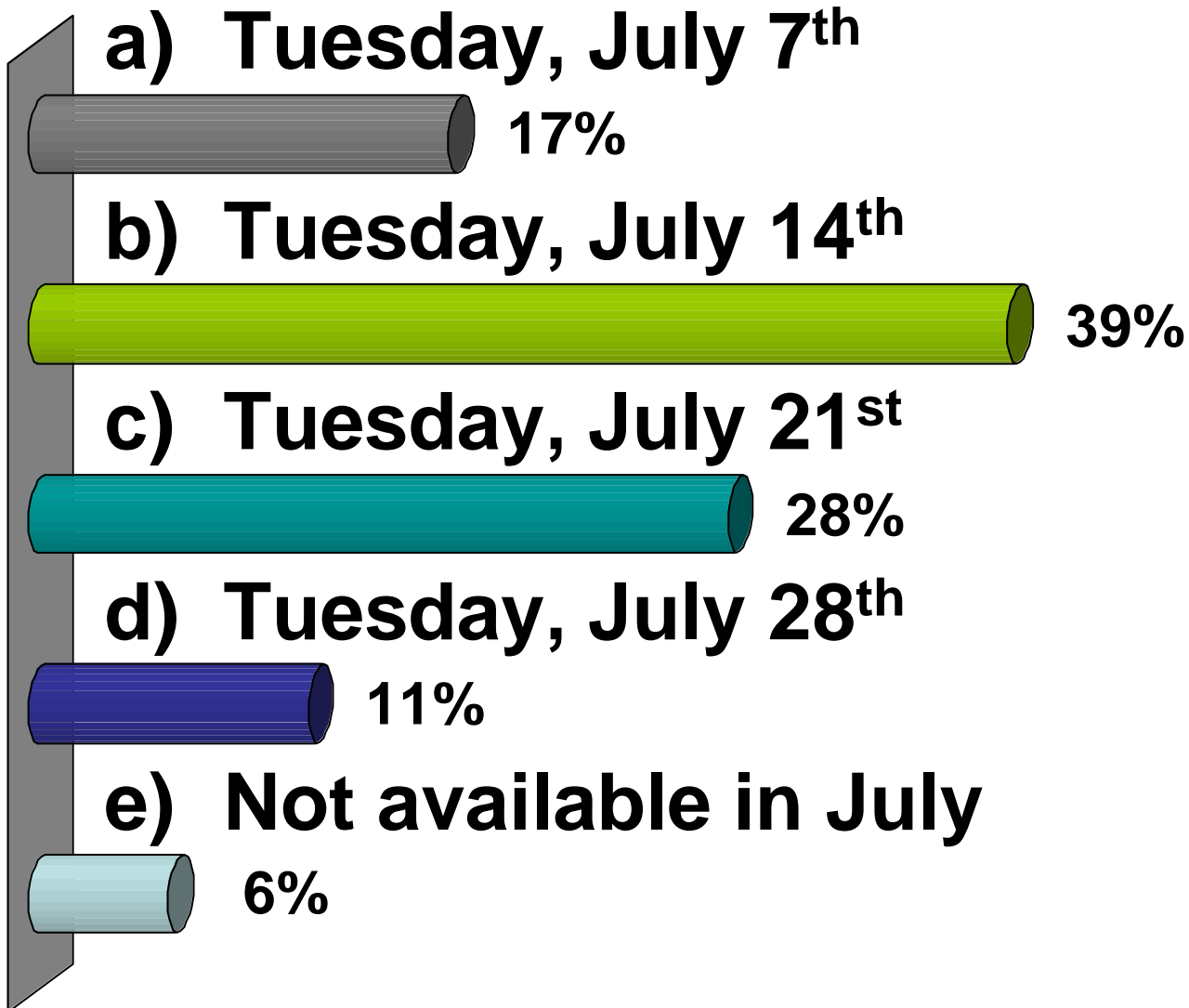

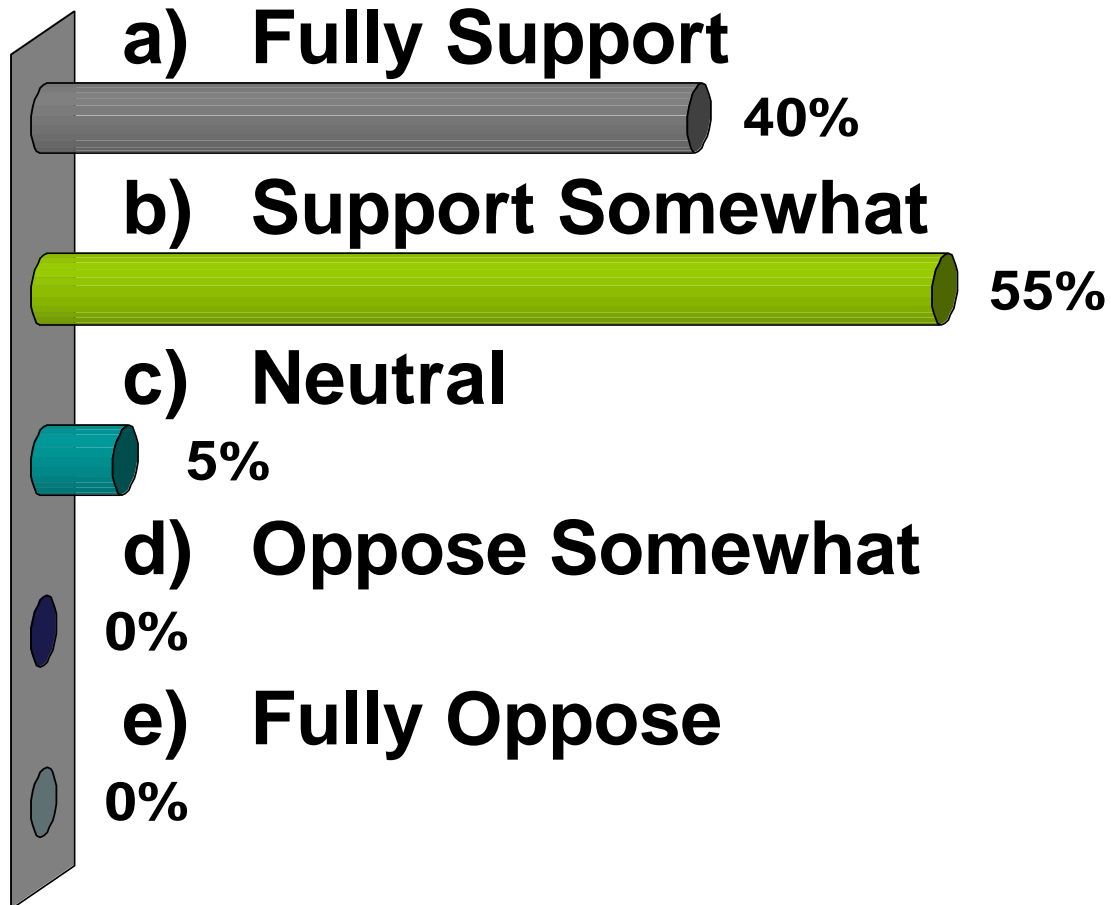


Scope/Purview

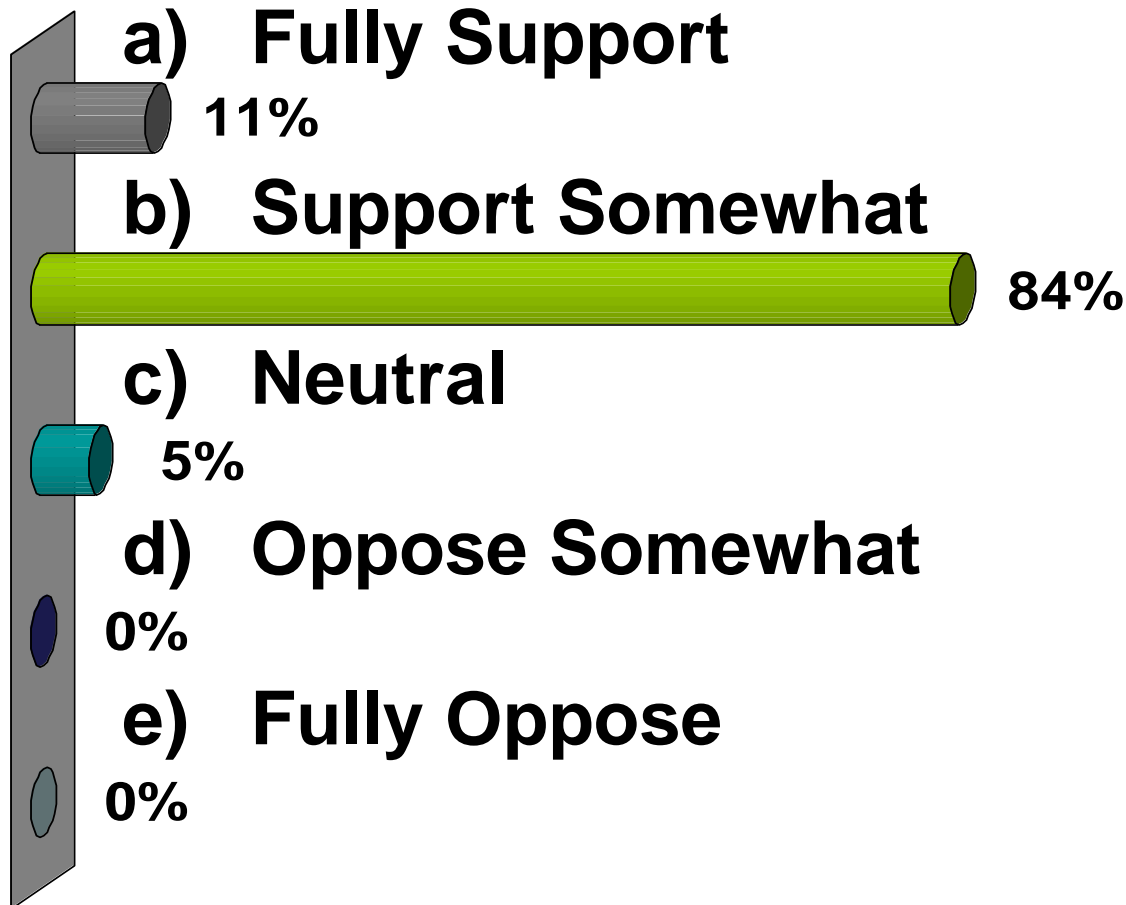
Defined as the committee's charge or main issues/specific areas of responsibility.

The Public Involvement Subcommittee's goal is to have OPIS focus on gaps in coverage, not duplicate the work of existing bodies.

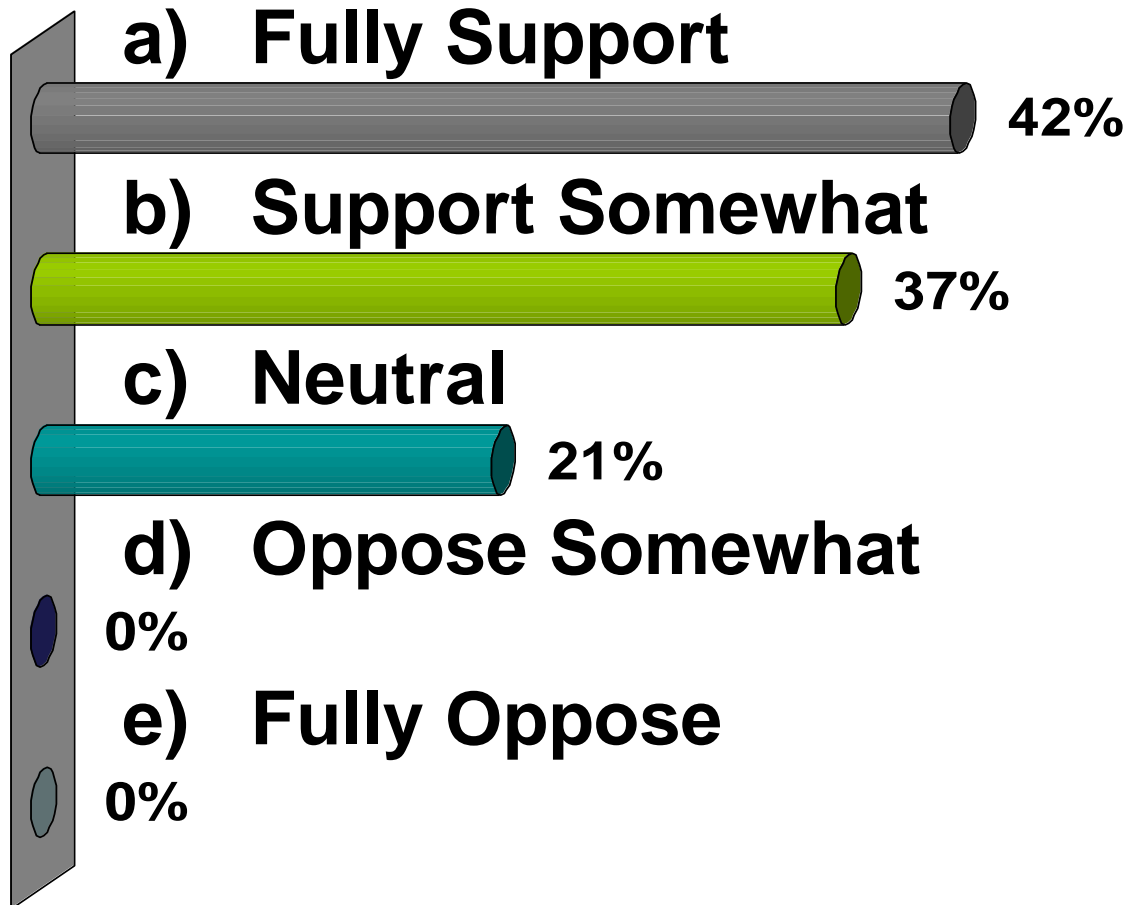
1. How comfortable are you with the “Planning and Development” function in the Scope/Purview?



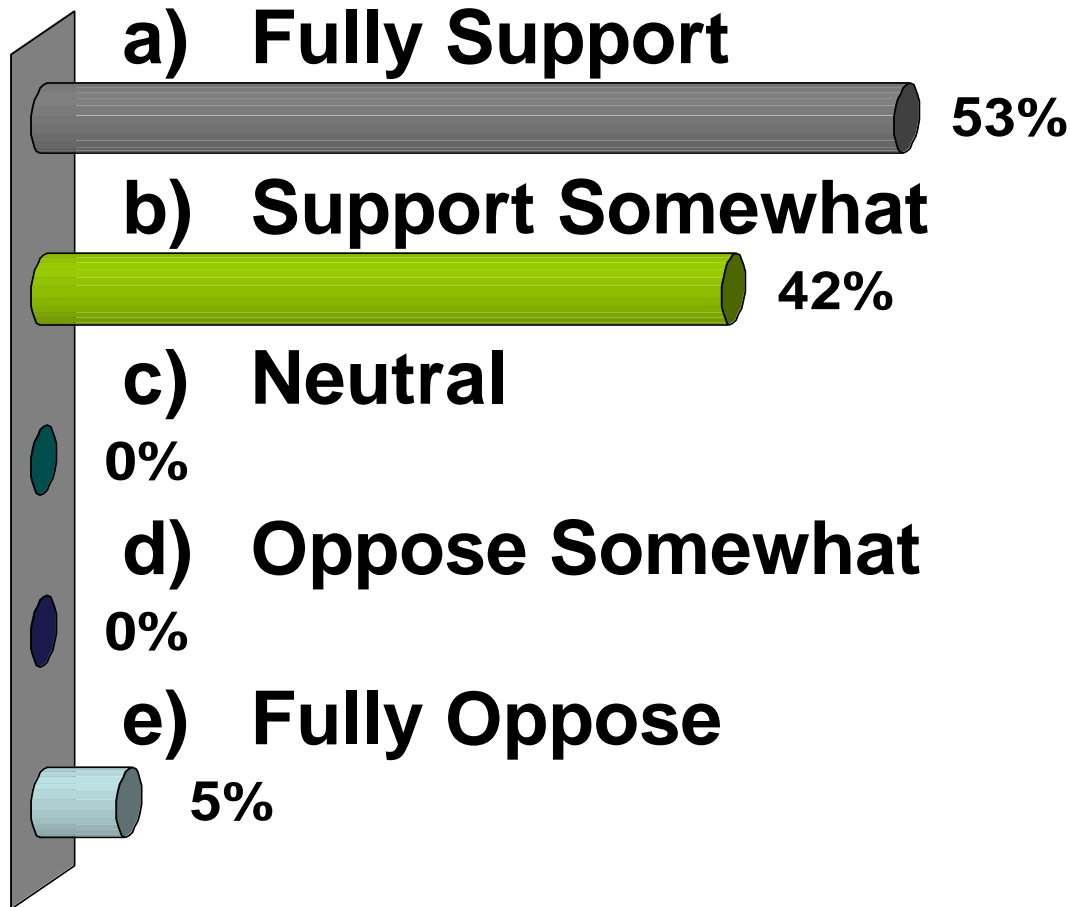
2. How comfortable are you with the “Sustainability” function in the Scope/Purview?



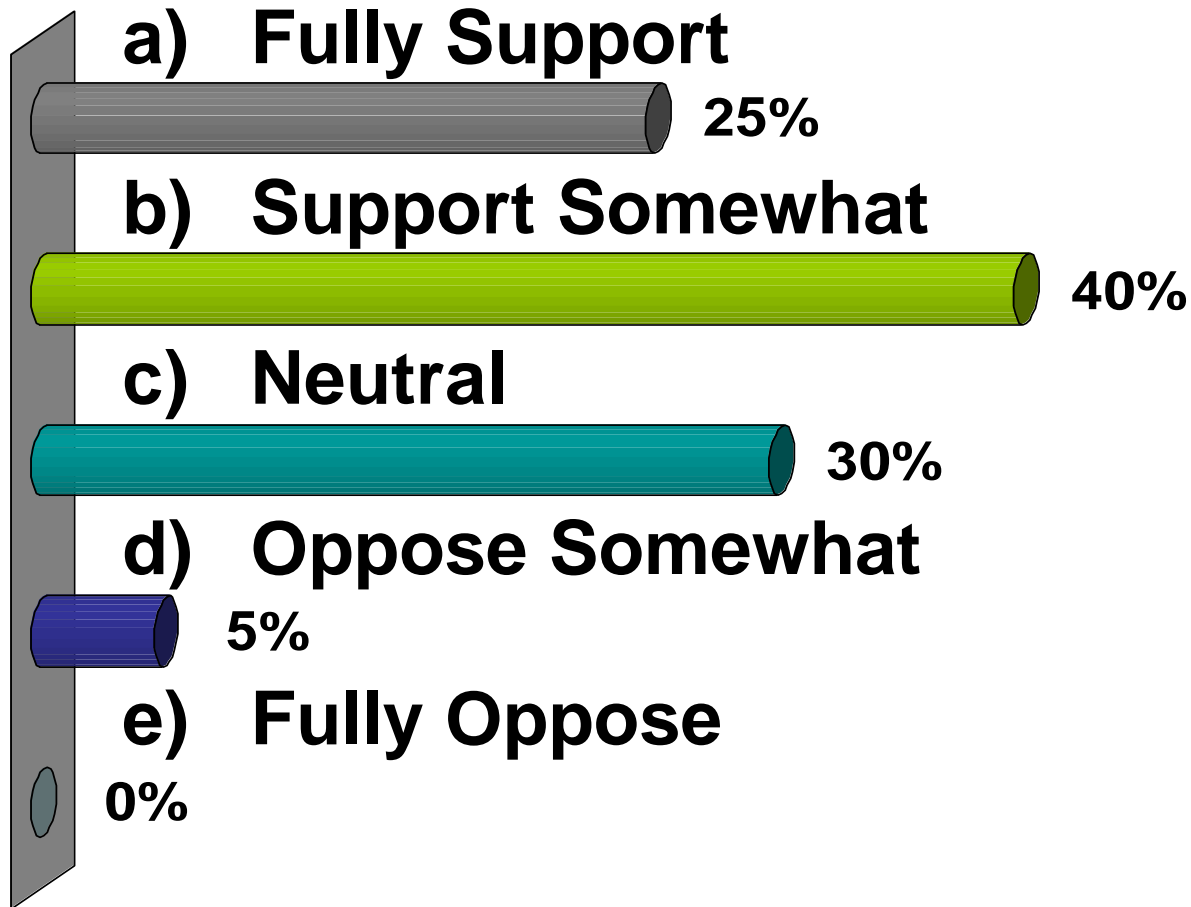
3. How comfortable are you with the “Community Agreements” function in the Scope/Purview?

Sponsorship

2. What is your second choice for a sponsorship structure at this moment in time?

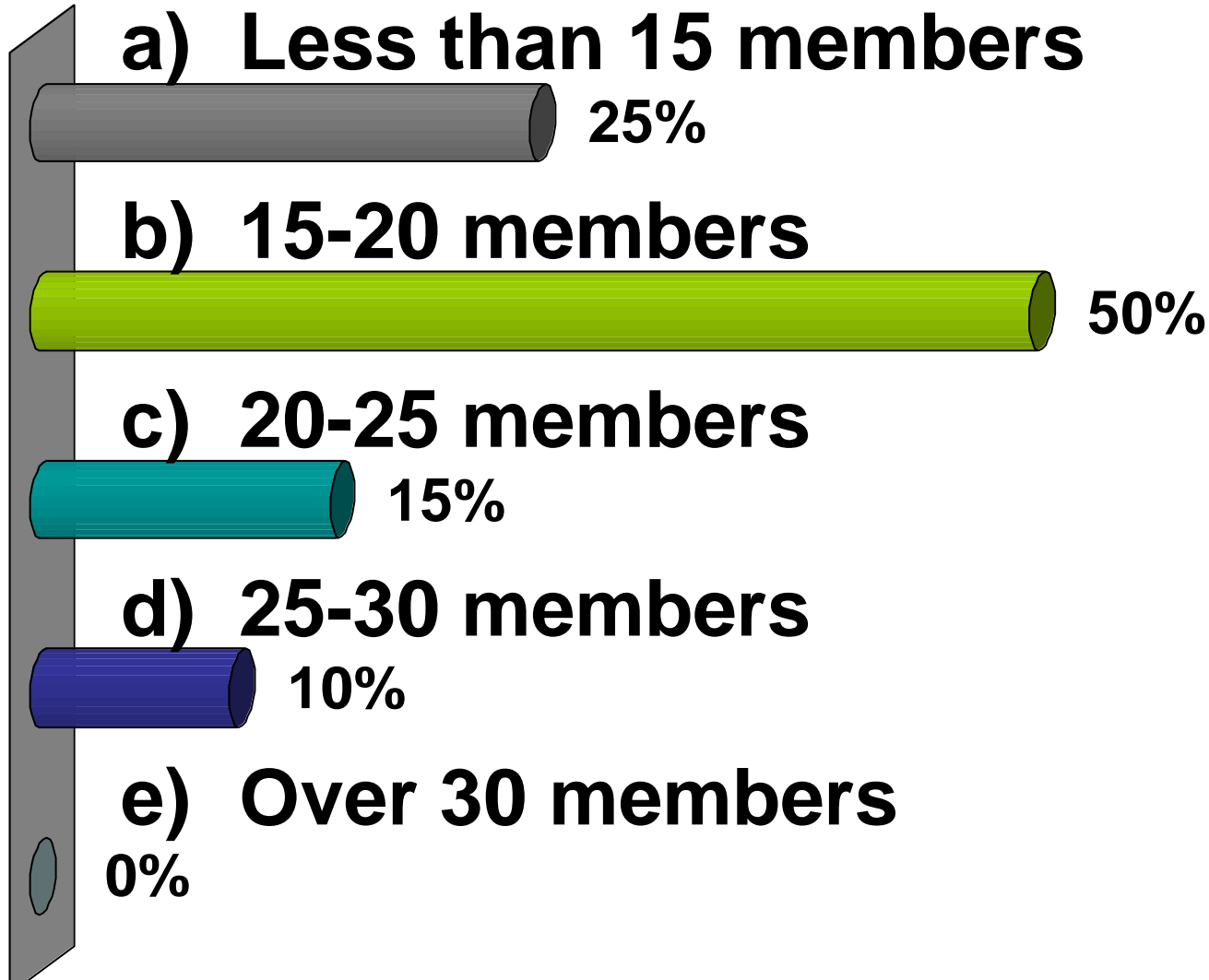


Membership

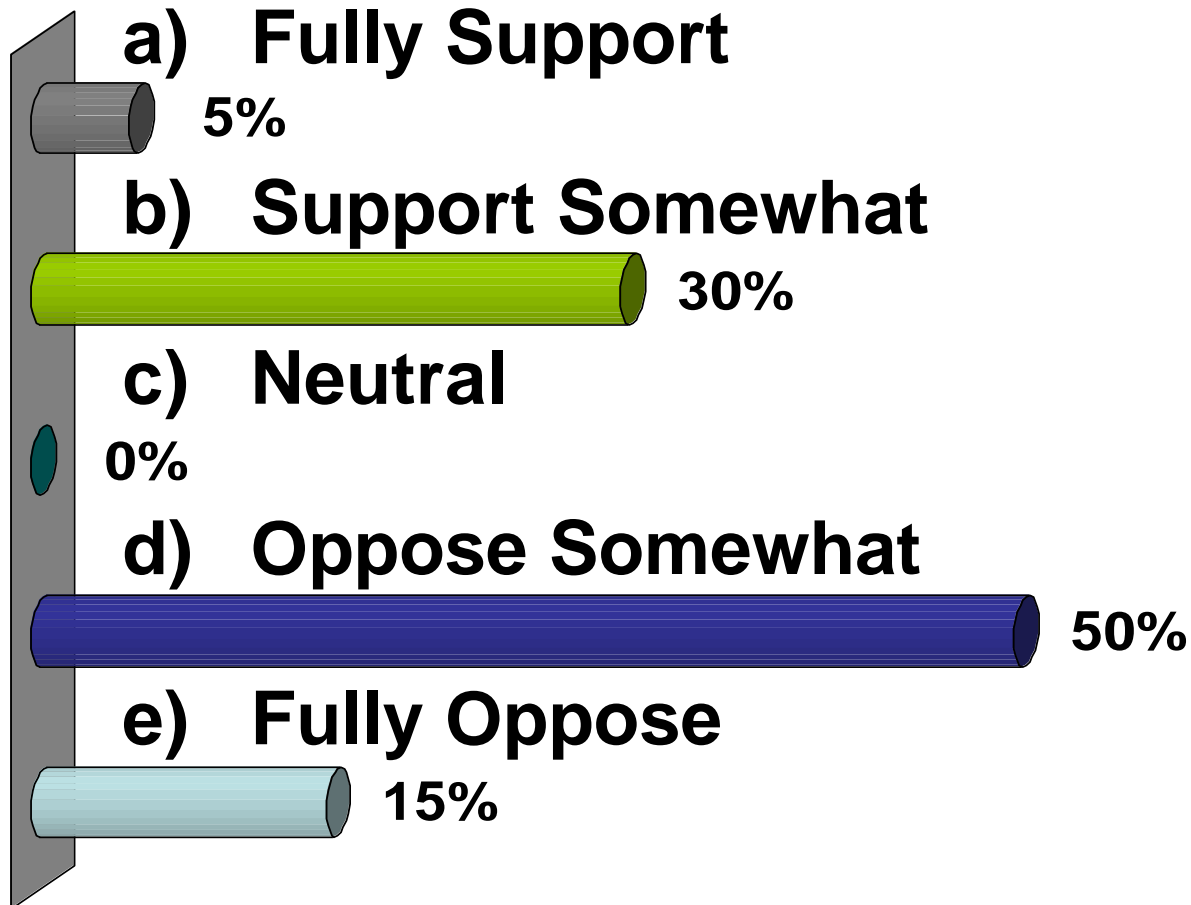
Defined as the size and composition of the future OPIS.

In other words, how many members should be on the committee, what interests should be at the table, and what role should they play?

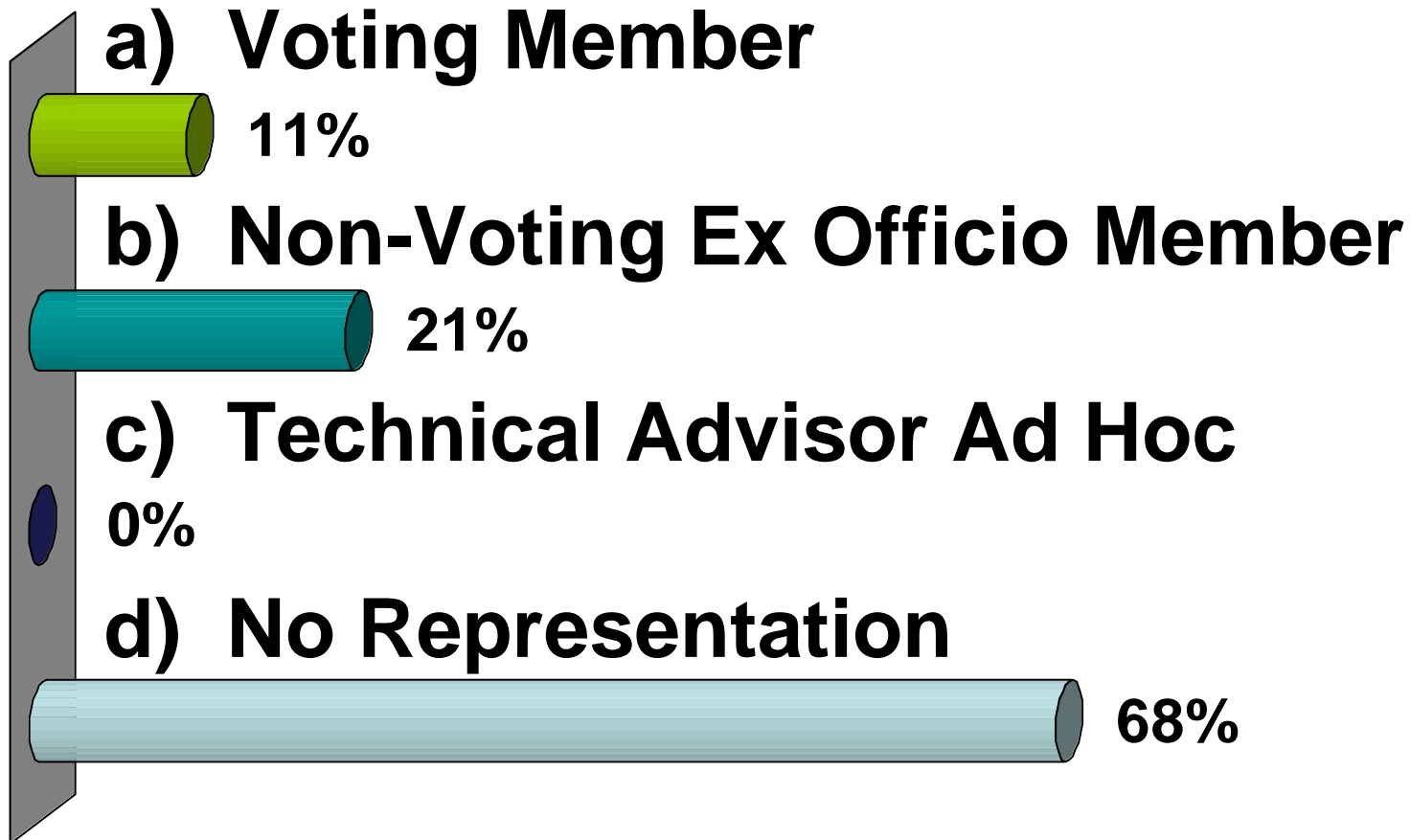
1. What is the ideal size of the OPIS committee?



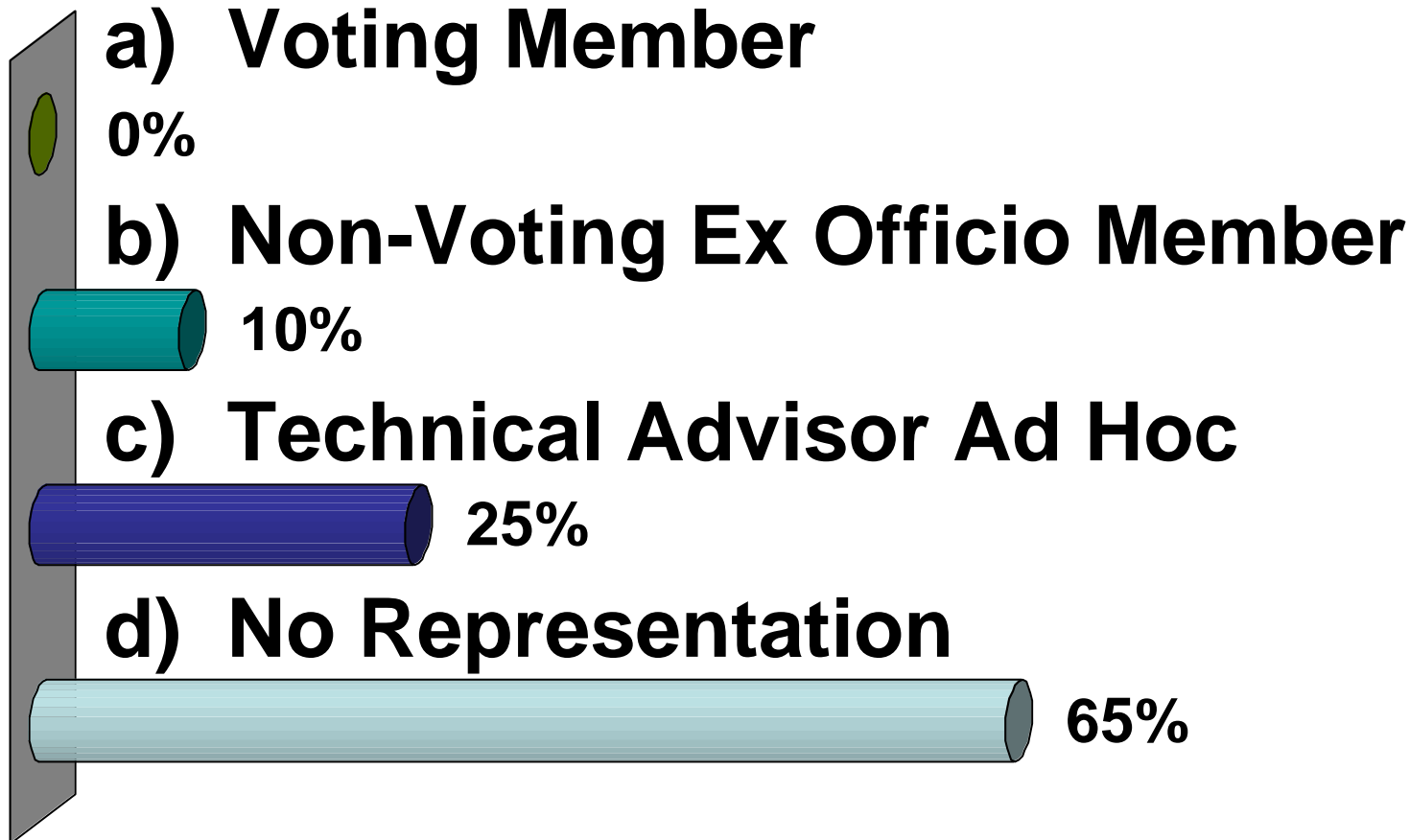
2. How comfortable are you with the current PAG interests participating in OPIS?



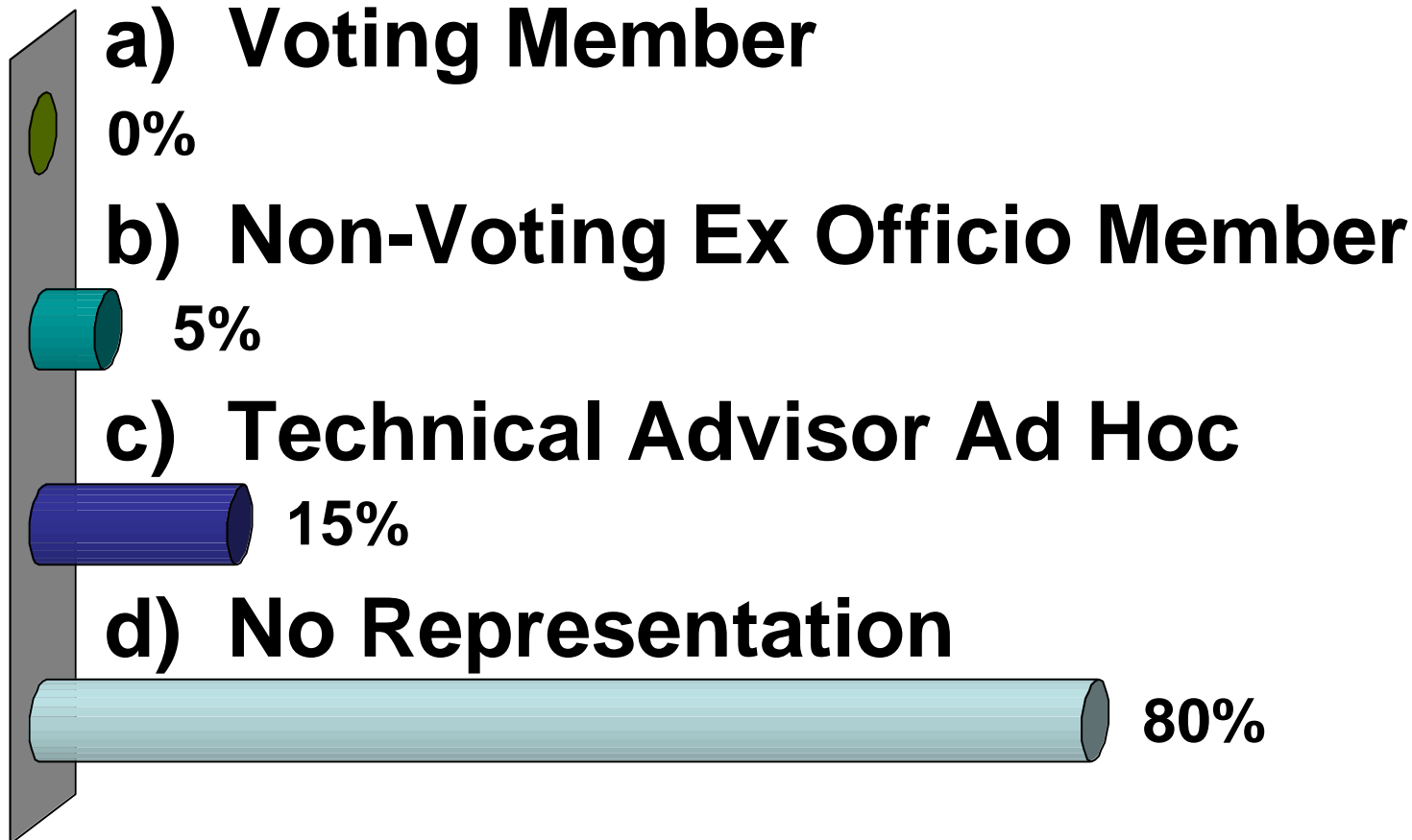
3. Elected Officials belong in which category?



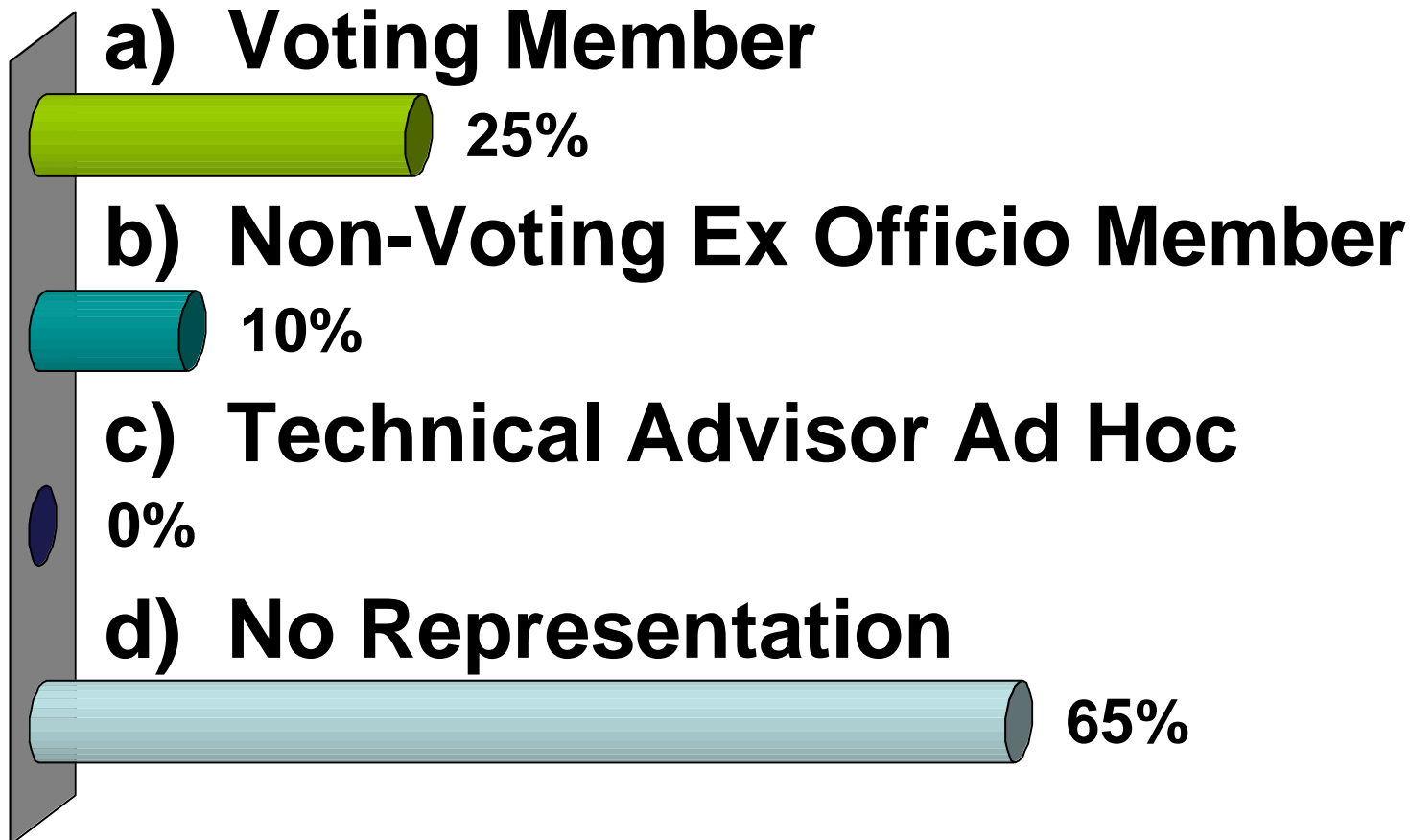
4. Executive Branch (Governor's office, state agency) belongs in which category?



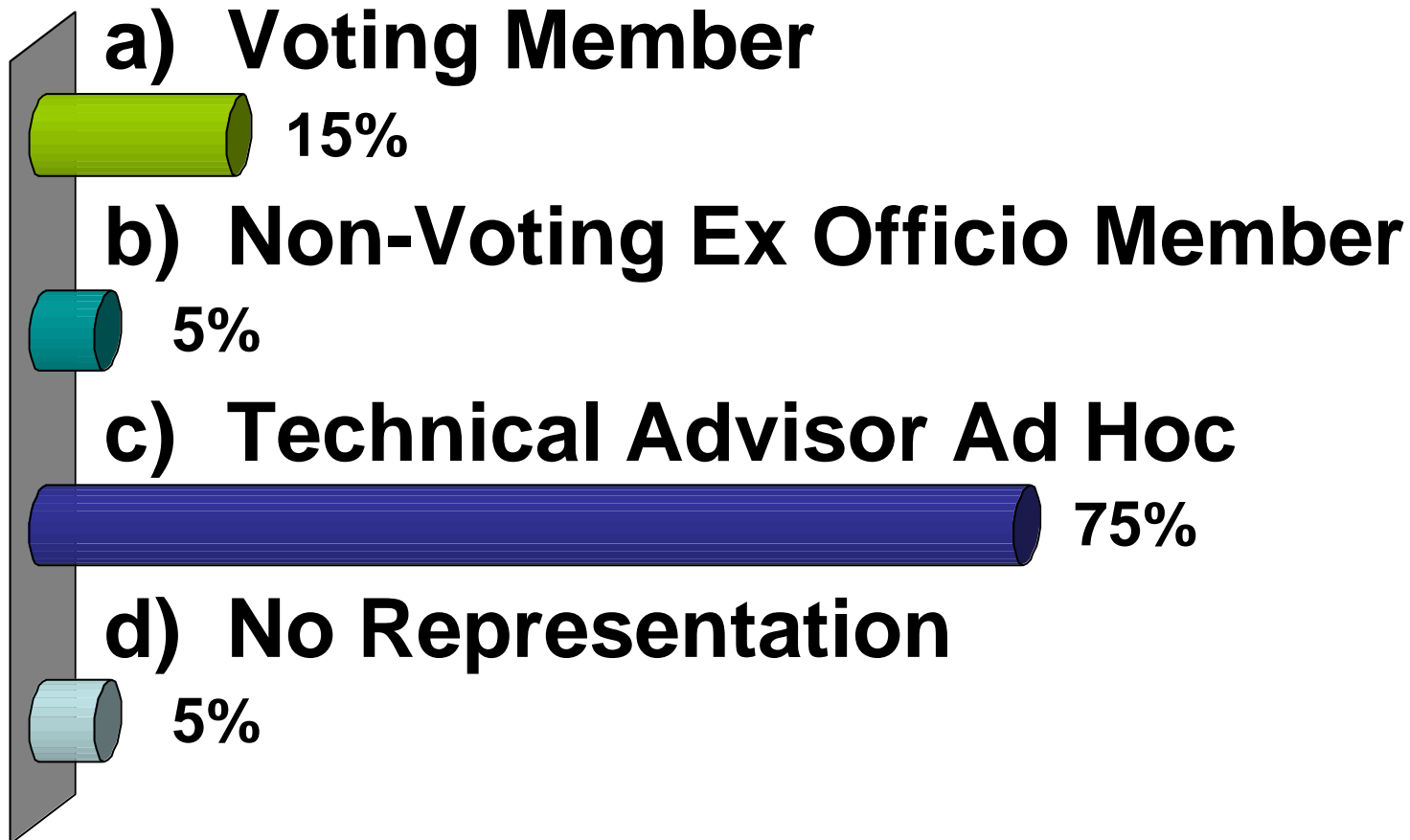
5. Legislative Branch (state legislator) belongs in which category?



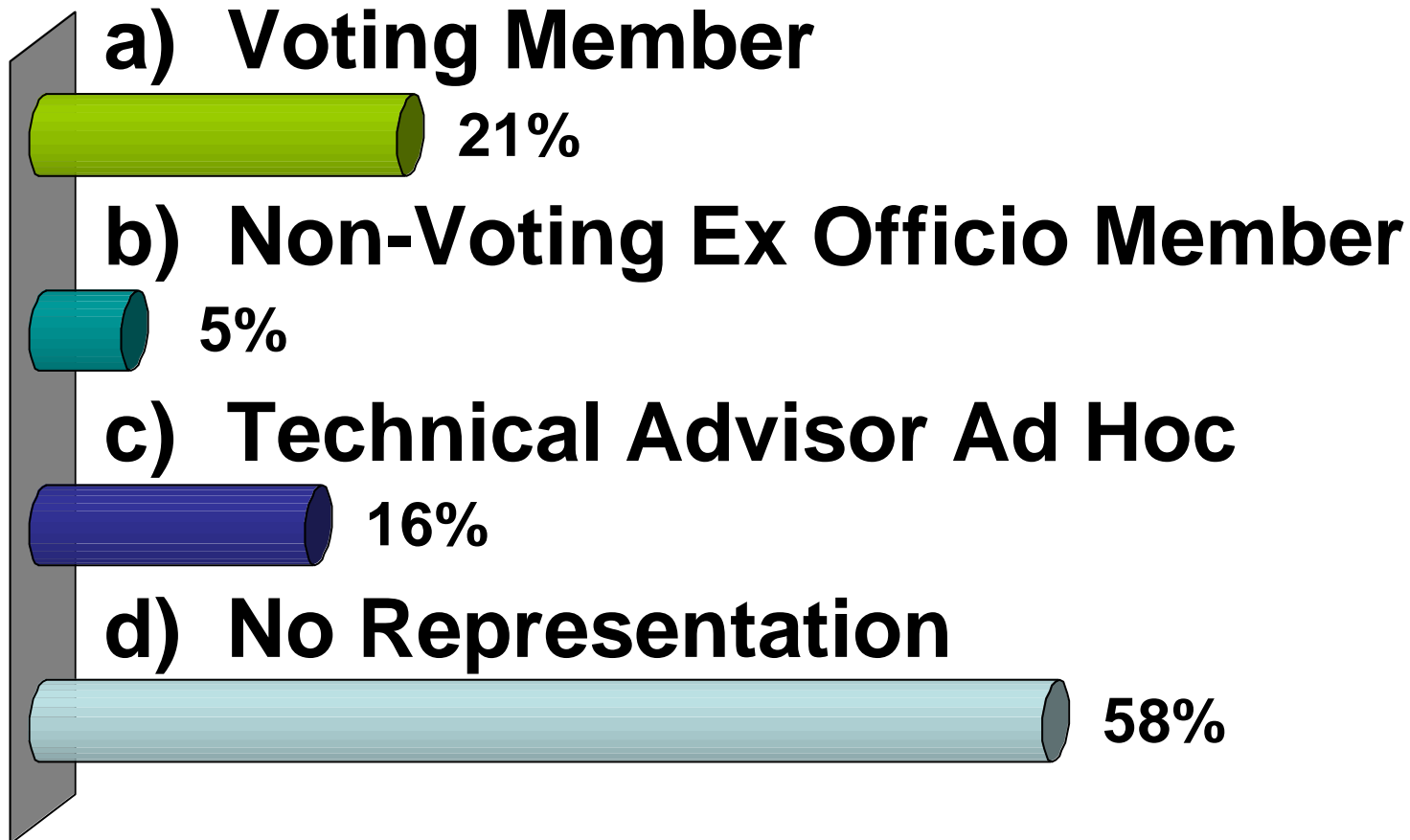

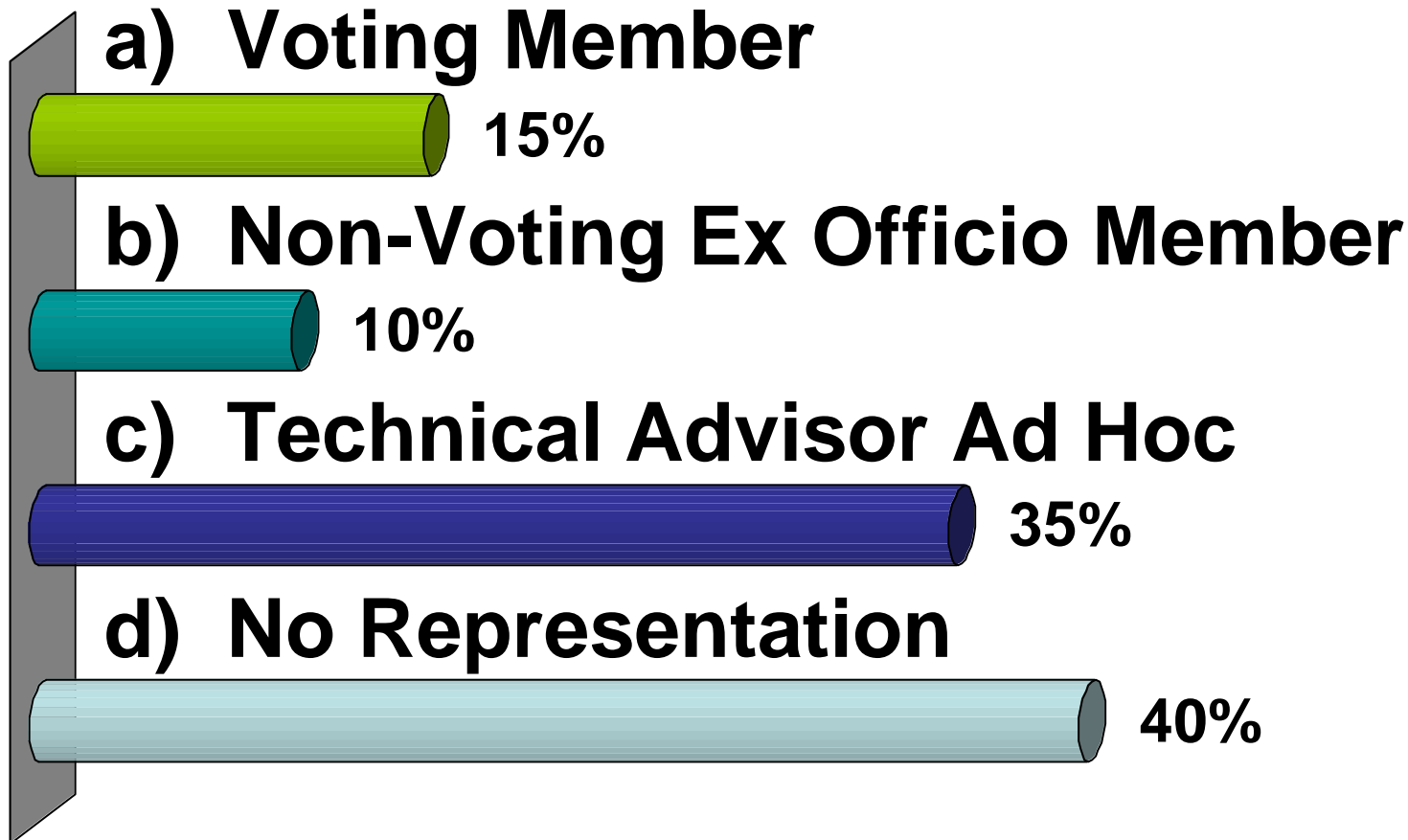
