

EXAMPLES: AIRPORT FUTURES SUSTAINABILITY GOALS

ENVIRONMENT

- **Climate Change:** PDX controlled airport operations will achieve carbon neutrality by 2035.
- **Natural Resources:** No net loss of significant habitat within the ecosystem due to PDX development.
- **Waste Management:** PDX will be zero waste by 2035.

SOCIAL

- **Public Involvement & Education:** Engage stakeholders to insure transparency, understanding, input opportunities and accountability in airport decisions and provide for continuous improvement on our commitment to sustainability.
- **Aircraft Noise:** Replace VHF Omni-directional Range navigation aid used for noise abatement with satellite-based navigation (Area Navigation -RNAV, RNP) by 2035.
- **Local Culture & Heritage:** PDX will capitalize on its position as a major gateway to the region to prominently showcase the region's culture and heritage through architecture, incorporation of art and history in to major capital projects and use of exhibit space within the terminal building.
- **Multi-Modal:** Expand and diversify passenger and employee transportation options, reduce curbside pick-up drop-off and manage transportation demand to preserve mobility for all modes within the airport area.

ECONOMIC

- **Financial Viability:** Develop, adopt and maintain an airport master plan that can be effectively phased to balance operating and capital costs in a way that keeps PDX cost competitive.
- **Lifecycle Cost:** Capture and assess the lifecycle cost of development, operation and maintenance by 2035.
- **Airport Area Economic Development:** Preserve and enhance opportunities for airport dependent and airport related businesses in and around PDX.
- **Jobs:** Preserve the significant transport and warehousing job base in the vicinity of PDX as an important part of the regional economy and a compatible industry in an area influenced by the operation of the airport.
