Noise Work Group - Recommendations for PAG

- Two recommendations from the Noise Work Group are included on page 54 of the Final PAG Report:
- **New #12:** The Port, City, and community should work collaboratively, wherever possible, on a legislative agenda and community enhancement concepts related to aircraft noise impacts.
- **New #13:** The Port and City should continue to support implementation of the PDX Fly Quiet Program and other recommendations from the Part 150 Noise Compatibility Study, and work to ensure good communication and coordination on noise abatement efforts among the City and Port noise programs, PDX Citizen Noise Advisory Committee, PDX Community Advisory Committee, and broader community.



Noise Work Group - Next Steps

- Next Meeting: Tuesday, June 1, 2010
 - Identify mitigation strategies that working group recommends as focus for PDX.
- Task #3
 - Identify strategy for development of mitigation boundaries.
- Task #4
 - Match mitigation strategies/measures and mitigation boundaries. Develop mitigation plan recommendations.
- Task #5
 - Finalize recommendations and produce report.
- Expected completion date: Fall 2010



Feedback from Stakeholder Outreach and Public Meetings

- 4 stakeholder meetings, 2 public meetings, 1 PAG subcommittee
- 94 in attendance
- Special thanks to PAG members participating in these meetings: Patrick, Fred, Denny, Alesia, Vicki, Bob, Maryhelen
- Summary of Key Comments on Overall Outcome/Public Engagement:
 - Positive outcome not expected at outset of process
 - Venue for meaningful public involvement post Airport Futures (PDX CAC)
 - How to address issues where immediate action required (interim PDX CAC meetings or email communications)
 - Impressed with level of community influence in process and future engagement through PDX CAC
 - Timeframe for convening PDX CAC (winter 2010-11)



Feedback from Stakeholder Outreach and Public Meetings

- Summary of Key Comments on Natural Resources:
 - Value of environmental mitigation/enhancement package v. environmental zoning (package superior, more holistic)
 - Was Audubon involved in development of the natural resource proposal? (Yes)
 - Coordination with Columbia Slough Watershed Council and others on enhancement efforts (Yes, CSWC and other key stakeholders will provide input on the selection of projects)
 - Is there an opportunity to use enhancement money as matching funds for grants, bundle annual funds to maximize impact? (Yes)
 - Enforcement of agreement (PDX CAC oversight, and City will apply overlays if agreement is terminated)
 - General questions re: impact of p and c zones on property



City Land Use Plan Natural Resource Agreement
