## Directions to Facility

From I-205 northbound or southbound: Take I-205 to Airport Way eastbound exit (Exit 24B), take Airport Way east to 122<sup>nd</sup> (third traffic light), left onto 122nd, left onto Marine Drive, go approximately 4.3 miles, look for the blue Air Fire Station/National Weather Service sign, take left onto service road, take fork to the right to Air Fire Station parking lot. Conference room entrance on eastside of building.

From NE 33<sup>rd</sup> Avenue: Take 33<sup>rd</sup> Avenue north to Marine Drive, turn right on Marine Drive, go approximately 1.3 miles, look for the blue Air Fire Station/National Weather Service sign, take right onto service road, take fork to the right to Air Fire Station parking lot. Conference room entrance on eastside of building.

From I-5 southbound: Take I-5 south to Marine Drive exit (Exit 307), follow signs for Marine Drive east, go approximately 3.6 miles eastbound on Marine Drive, look for the blue Air Fire Station/National Weather Service sign, take left onto service road, take fork to the right to Air Fire Station parking lot. Conference room entrance on eastside of building.

From I-5 northbound: Take I-5 north to Delta Park exit (Exit 307), follow signs to Marine Drive, go approximately 3.6 miles eastbound on Marine Drive, look for the blue Air Fire Station/National Weather Service sign, take left onto service road, take fork to the right to Air Fire Station parking lot. Conference room entrance on eastside of building.
